Please consider joining us for the **April 3 and 4 chapel services**. This is the Easter celebration and the children will have a procession with palms. It is always one of our favorites!

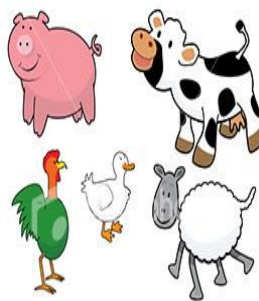

## CONGRATULATIONS:



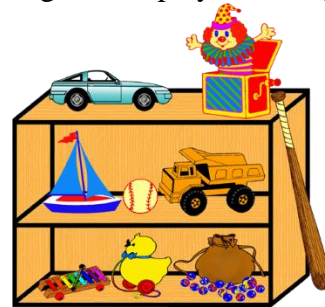
In March, Senator Nancy King was presented the Maryland Senate First Citizen Award. What an outstanding honor! The award, established in 1992, recognizes individuals who
