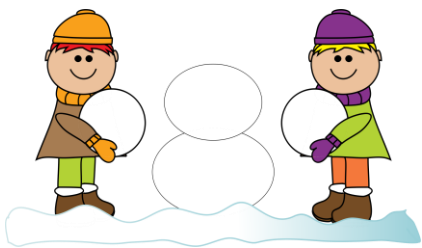

SNOW POLICY/DELAYED OPENING:

Covenant United Methodist Preschool follows the Montgomery County Public School's (MCPS) weather related announcements as far as snow days, delayed openings, or emergency closings. The school will be closed on all snow days.

On delayed openings (one or two hour MCPS delays) our preschool will open at 10:15 AM.

If MCPS closes early, CUMP will "close" at 11:45 am for all classes. Do you receive weather alerts from MCPS regarding school closings? This is helpful even if you don't have children in the school system because we follow MCPS decisions here at CUMP. PRESCHOOL REGISTRATION:

Registration for 2019-20 preschool classes will begin for our currently enrolled students in **January 2019**. Information will be sent home with your child inside the buckets in early January. Please note, your financial account must be current in order to register for the next academic year.

Preschool & Terrific Two's "Open House" will be held Saturday, January 26th at 9:00 am. Prospective families for children ages 2-5 years, who will not attend Kindergarten yet, will tour the building, see the classrooms, and have time to ask the directors any questions. If you have a friend or neighbor who might be interested, please let them know about this opportunity now! We so appreciate your help spreading the "good news" about our wonderful school.

TUITION DISCOUNT:

Do you know a family that is looking for a preschool to attend? If you do, you could be rewarded! With every new student registration, payment and reference of your name, the preschool will give you **10 percent off your next month's tuition**. For example – if you refer a new family to our school and they register a new student, you will receive a one-time 10 percent discount off the next month's tuition. *The tuition discount will only apply to families that are new to our school – existing families do not count.*
