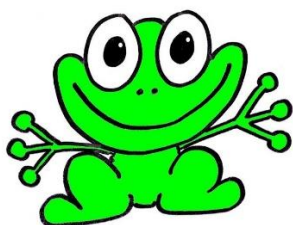
My Education!
