Donuts with Dads (4 year olds):

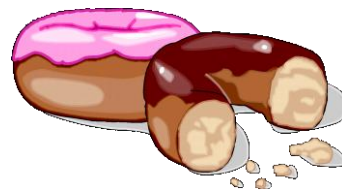
"Donuts with Dads" is a special time for Dad to enjoy a breakfast snack and spend some play time inside the classroom with his child on the following dates:

Fall Parent Teacher Conferences:

Fall parent-teacher conferences will be held the week of Nov 11-18. Each class is assigned one conference day and teachers will meet with each family for 10 minutes, focusing on your child’s social and emotional development and behavior. If you feel you need additional time to discuss your child’s growth and development, please let your child’s teacher know and she will be happy to meet again another day for as long as necessary. For your convenience and to maximize your child’s education and your tuition dollars class will be held on conference days. Assistant teachers will teach classes with the aid of a substitute.

Sign ups for fall conferences will be posted in early November. Most classes will sign up electronically via sign up genius. Please note that in February and March you will have the opportunity to conference with teachers again, this time for 20 minutes, with a focus on

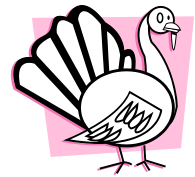
your child’s academic strengths and areas for growth.

Snow Delayed Openings Emergency Closings:

Covenant Preschool follows the Montgomery County Public School's (MCPS) weather related announcements as far as snow days, delayed openings or emergency closings. The school will be closed on all MCPS snow days. **On MCPS delayed opening days the preschool will open at 10:15am. If MCPS closes schools early due to weather conditions the preschool will close at 11:45am.** The preschool allows for four snow days. If necessary, additional school time will be scheduled to compensate for closings due to inclement weather. Should the State Superintendent, Maryland State Department of Education, pardon snow days, CUMP will follow their specific guidelines.
