## SPECIAL OCTOBER EVENTS

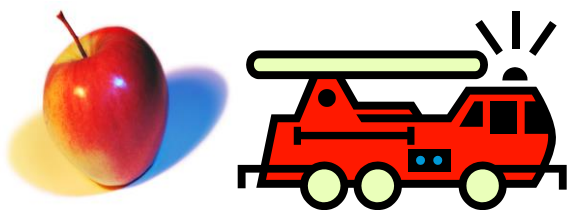
New this year - on Thursday, October 5 our 3 year old classes will be visited by a local librarian who will bring her favorite stories and have a special storytime with our children.
