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Dear Covenant Families,

Welcome! We here on the Covenant Preschool staff are so excited to begin this year.

We had a wonderful turnout for our play dates prior to school opening. Thank you to all families who joined us. Loved seeing you!

As we begin the start of the school year, please know it is very common that the first week of class, even the first month, can be challenging for some children. Tears and uncertainty when separating from mom or dad is totally age appropriate. Please walk your child into the building and to their classroom and sign them in. The staff and I are accustomed to tears and screams and we will gently handle the situation from there.



What we need from you is: say good-bye to your child; give him/her a kiss and hug; tell him/her that you love them and will return after class to pick them up. Delaying your departure only makes the situation harder for

your child so please leave right away after saying good-bye (seriously!). I am happy to call you throughout the morning with candid updates the first few weeks so you can leave without worrying all morning if your child is ok. If your child is having an especially hard time, I will tell you. Also, please be prompt in picking up your child... it really does matter. If you are late at pick up time, your son or daughter may worry

you are not coming (this remains true all year – on time pick up is very important to preschoolers).

CARPOOLS: Many parents participate in carpools. Carpools are great! If other people will be transporting your child, please be sure their name is listed on the Pick Up Authorization Form you completed at time of registration. Staff **will not** release a child to anyone not on your list. The staff will ask for a picture ID if we do not know the person. If your child goes home with another child for a play date, the teacher will need a permission note from you. If an emergency occurs and someone other than a person listed on your form must pick up your child, simply call the main office at 301-527-9300 or email Lisabroadman@covenant-umc.org.

FOOD ALLERGIES AND ASTHMA: A *Food Allergy Action Plan* will need to be completed for any child who has a food allergy. The form may be downloaded off our website (www.covenantumpreschool.org) or please ask me for a copy of the form. If your child has severe and/or numerous allergies it may be best if the parent provide their child's daily snack. Children with asthma severe enough they may possibly require treatment at school must complete an *Asthma Action Form* also obtainable from our school website or office.



CHAPEL AND SHOW 'N TELL: Chapel and Show 'n Tell will begin in October for all classes.

TUITION: Monthly tuition is due the first day of each month and is late after the 10th of the month. **Your September tuition is due by September 10, 2019.** A \$35 late fee will be assessed after the 10th. **Please write your child's name on your check in the memo section.** A locked collection box is located in the main hallway – please, do not send your check into the classroom to the teacher.

BUCKETS: Your child's bucket should come to school every day – no exceptions unless noted by the teacher. This is the method used to send art/craft projects and parent notes back and forth. No toys in the buckets, please.

STUDENT ABSENCES: If your child is ill and will not be coming to class; please call the school office 301-527-9300 and leave a message or email Lisabroadman@covenant-umc.org before 9:15am. If your child's teacher prefers you contact her directly, please do so.

COMMUNICATING WITH TEACHERS: If you need to talk with your child's teacher, please contact her to set up a time mutually convenient for both of you. The teachers are here to serve your family and welcome the opportunity to share your child's progress and discuss concerns you may have. Please note formal parent-teacher conferences will be held in both November and February.

CLASS LISTS: A list of children in your child's class will be sent out. ***If there is an error in your address, email, or telephone number, please write the correction on a piece of paper and return to me at drop off or pick up or email me with changes.*** Late September after all corrections have been received, an updated roster will then be forwarded to the class.

FINANCIAL QUESTIONS: The school's bookkeeper/administrative assistant is happy to discuss any accounting questions you may have. Please stop by and see her. If you need a receipt for tuition please let Mrs. Kennedy know and she will provide them to you monthly.

PRESCHOOL BOARD: The Preschool Board of Directors has two parent representatives. If you would like to be a representative, please see me. The Board is our governing body and helps to make the school run smoothly and efficiently. Please feel free to get to know them.

PRESCHOOL DAYS OFF: The preschool has no vacation days during the month of September. Even though MCPS may be closed or have early releases, CUMP does not follow those dates. Please check our school calendar for details.

PARKING LOT: Please remember to drive slowly in the parking lot. Your children can be difficult to see and many people drive large vehicles. Please hold your child's hand in the parking lot.
